

SUMMER CAMP Quick Facts

Daily Schedule

Programs are one week in length. All programs run Monday to Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Supervised breaks include mid-morning, mid-afternoon and lunch breaks. Breaks are held outdoors, weather permitting. Campers must provide their own lunch and snacks.

Drop Off and Pick-Up

Camp programs begin at 9:00 a.m. Please drop off your child no more than 10 minutes prior to the program start time. Children MUST be picked up promptly at the end of the camp day or at the completion of after hours care. **There will be a late pick up fee after 4:05 p.m. of \$10 each day for campers not registered in After Hours Care.**

After Hours Care

Extended care consists of supervised activities available from 4:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. Extended care is offered on a first-come, first-served basis from Monday through Thursday only. Limited spaces are available. Fee for **One Week** - \$40.00. **There will be a late pick-up fee of \$1 each day for campers enrolled in after hours care who are picked up after 5:00 p.m.**

Lunch and Snack

Campers must provide their own lunches, snacks and drinks. Refrigeration for lunches, snacks and drinks is not available. **No peanuts** please. **Supervision is provided for all campers over the lunch hour and breaks.**

Special Needs

If your child has special needs, details must be included with your registration form. Please note that **we cannot provide one-on-one supervision or specific medical support.**

Class Size

Each program session is limited to a maximum enrolment of **15 campers.**

Withdrawals

If you wish to cancel your registration, we must receive your request at least **30 days** prior to the start of the camp session in question. Under these circumstances a full refund (less a **\$95 administration fee**) will be issued. Within 29 to 14 days prior to the start of the registered camp session, cancellation requests will not be accepted; however, fees paid can be applied to a different camp session or toward an equivalent program in the same calendar year. No refund or transfer will be available for cancellation requests received 14 or fewer days prior to the start of the registered camp session except at the discretion of the Artistic Director and only in consideration of special circumstances.

Playmakers! Theatre School reserves the right to de-register any camper deemed to be incompatible with the program. In such a case, a pro-rata refund will be issued for unattended program days.

Cancellations

Playmakers! Theatre School reserves the right to cancel camp programs if minimum enrolment levels are not met. A full refund will be issued in the event of program cancellation.

What to Wear

For all programs, comfortable clothing is best. **Parents and campers are advised that crafts can be messy!** Although some clothing protection will be provided, accidents may still occur. Parents are encouraged to send along a spare set of clothes just in case. A number of daily activities will take place outside, weather permitting. Parents may send sunscreen with campers if desired, or apply it before arriving at camp. Campers should bring hats to wear during outdoor activities.

Final Presentation

Each camp session concludes with a presentation for family and friends on Friday afternoon at 3:00 p.m. Campers are free to leave with their parents/guardians at the conclusion of their presentation.

Session Dates and Prices

Camp programs run Monday to Friday from 9 am to 4 pm. Fees are \$325 per session. Fees include all materials.
